Privacy Policy

EDCi

Your privacy is important to us, we are thoughtful about the personal information we ask you to provide and the personal information that we collect about you. Electroline Data Communications Inc. ("EDCi", "our", "us" or "we") will not collect personally identifiable information ("PII") that you do not volunteer. We will not sell, share, or rent PII to third parties without your consent, except as specifically described below.

If you choose to register or submit PII or other information to us via this website, you agree to the use of such information in accordance with this privacy policy.

Below we explain how we collect, use, and share information about you, along with the choices that you have with respect to that information.

Information Collection and Use

As a general visitor to our website, EDCi does not collect any PII about you. We automatically record information sent by your browser in server logs, including your IP address, the pages you visit, and other non-personally identifiable information, which we use to analyze our web traffic and administer our servers.

EDCi collects PII and other data voluntarily provided by visitors to our Website for a variety of purposes, including but not limited to:

- Information requests and emails.
- Publication distribution (newsletters, white papers, etc).
- Use of our services, including working with the EDCi team.
- Surveys requesting feedback on our services.
- Event registration (seminars, demonstrations, lunch and learns, etc).
- Resume submission for career opportunites.
- Contests and promotions.

Information we may collect as a result of voluntary submission may include, but not be limited to, name, company name, job title, mailing address, e-mail address, phone number, and fax number. EDCi uses reasonable efforts to maintain an accurate record of information submitted to our website. However, EDCi is not responsible for verifying the continued accuracy of this information. Visitors may update their information by using Contact us today in the applicable section of the website.

Events and Seminars

Throughout the year, EDCi sponsors a variety of educational and networking events. Registration for such events may require the collection of PII to be used in the development of attendance lists, nametags, and other event materials and may be shared with third parties involved in the planning and preparation of the event.



Information Disclosure

EDCi does not sell, trade, or rent any PII to third parties for marketing purposes. Such information may, however, be disclosed in the situations outlined below.

- As required by law through search warrant, subpoena, or other legal process.
- As part of any actual or threatened legal proceeding or alternative dispute resolution.
- When required, in order to deliver publications or materials as requested by a website visitor.
- As needed to facilitate seminars and events hosted by a third party or EDCi when disclosure is necessary for event planning and materials development.
- To provide information to affiliates of EDCi and nonaffiliated third parties who perform services for us in conjunction with any requests or inquiries made by you.

Information from Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. EDCi uses cookies and other technologies to help us identify and track visitors, and usage, as well as track and understand email campaign effectiveness and to deliver targeted ads.

Information We Collect from Other Sources

We may get information about you from other public sources.

We may also get information, such as a mailing address, from third party services about individuals who are not yet our customers, which we may use, for example, for marketing and advertising purposes like postcards and other mailers advertising our services.
